# ENERGY STAR® and Green Button Add-On

The ENERGY STAR® and Green Button Add-On includes the following features and capabilities:

## (1) Customer-Facing Web Portal Features

Feature	Definition
<b>Single-Tenant ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager Tools</b>	Full ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager site profile question list, by Primary Activity. Customers can calculate an ENERGY STAR® score in the Customer-facing Portal, or learn how to set up a connection with ENERGY STAR® Data Exchange to automatically upload ongoing electric and gas usage data from the Portal to their ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager account. ➤ Note: Data exchange requires an ESPM account. Generating a score does not.
<b>Multi-Tenant ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager Tools</b>	Enable site/building owners to calculate whole building energy usage (electricity and gas) from multiple utility-billed tenant accounts, and submit aggregate data to their ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager account to meet benchmarking ordinances. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meter-to-building mapping across customer accounts so that landlords can pull in data from their tenants</li> <li>• Tenant-landlord data sharing authorization</li> <li>• Validation of whole building data and transfer to their ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager account via ENERGY STAR® Data Exchange</li> </ul>
<b>Green Button Download (GBD) My Data®</b>	Enables monthly and interval usage data download in the standardized Green Button format for a building or service delivery point.
<b>Green Button Connect (GBC) My Data®</b>	Establishes a connection between the Customer-facing Portal and a third-party, GBC-enabled system. This allows users to automate the secure, bi-directional transfer of their energy usage data to/from authorized third parties, based on affirmative (opt-in) customer consent and control. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Note: Third-party providers must also support Green Button Connect</li> <li>➤ Note: Customer must provide authorization between their utility accounts</li> </ul>

### Definitions

**Customer Account:** Small Medium Business or Large Commercial or Industrial customer of the utility. This cannot be a residential customer.

**Primary Activity:** A classification of building occupancy, referring to the type of Site/building and activity occurring within the Site.
